Dear Parents / Carers

Beaufort Academy is on a journey of improvement to ensure it provides the best possible learning environment for all of its students. As part of this journey, and as previously communicated, the school will start the new academic year in September with a new name and new uniform.

**The school will be called Holmleigh Park High School**

This name reflects the school's place in its local community - the land the school is on and the adjacent park is called Holmleigh Park and was the preferred choice in the survey with the highest number of preferences. The school will have a new badge to go with the new name, as seen above.

From September the school will have a new uniform, which has been shared with the Student Voice Group.

The new uniform consists of:

- A navy blazer and school tie
- A sky blue shirt/blouse
- A v-necked jumper can be purchased from our uniform suppliers, with the school logo. This is optional and can be worn under the blazer, but not instead of a blazer.
- Either tailored black trousers, or the school skirt  
*Please note for trousers: no denim, leggings, fashion styles, zips other than the fly, extra tight, slim fit, miss sixty or baggy styles allowed*
- Plain black shoes with no logo or flashes  
*Please note: no trainers, Velcro, canvas shoes, boots or backless shoes*

The new uniform will be compulsory for all students from the start of the new academic year - September 2019. As we have shared with you before, Greenshaw Learning Trust will be subsidising the uniform for existing students by purchasing a blazer and tie for all students and a skirt for those students who request one. Further details regarding when the new uniform will be available will be communicated over the coming weeks.

We request that if you are in any doubt about the type of material, the tightness of the fabric, the style of the trouser or if they are trainers or shoes they are probably not correct. Go for the cautious approach. We ask that you keep receipts for school trousers and shoes so that if they are not the correct type then they can be easily changed.
